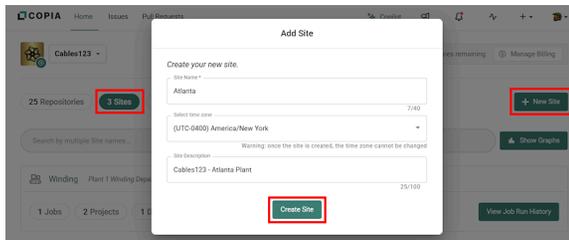

DL Config Reference

Create a Site

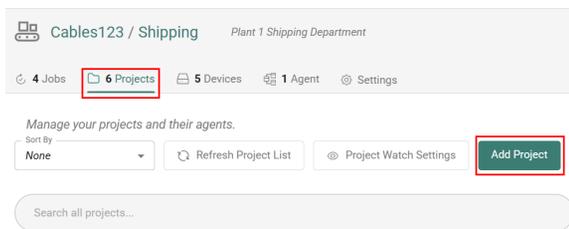
Using the Copia web app, click the **Sites** button on the Home page, and then click **New Site**. When the dialog opens, enter the name of your Site/Area, update the Time zone and add a description. Once complete, you can press the **Create Site** button.



Add a Project/Device

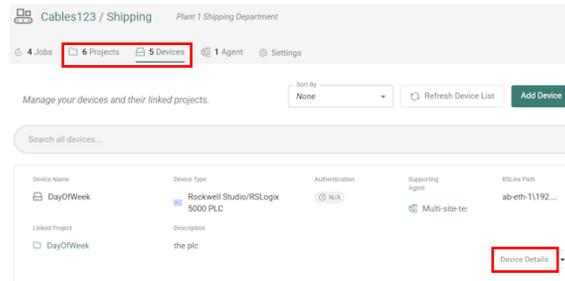
To add a new Project/Device from a Repository to your Site, you first should click the Sites tab from the Home page and choose the desired site from the list. At the top of the Site page, click the **Projects** tab. Choose the **Add Project** button and follow the "Add a new project" wizard from the top to the bottom.

*(NOTE: A Job is **not required** to Submit the Project, if you are already using a Sitewide job)*



Edit a Project or Device

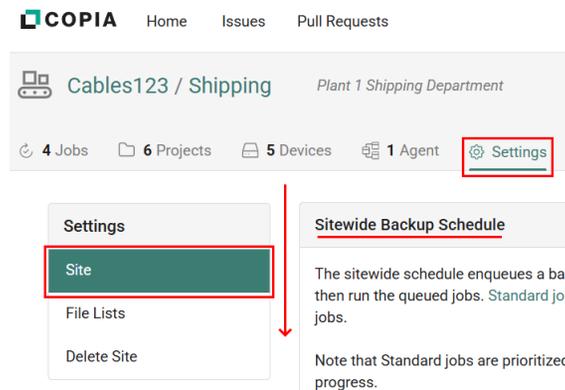
From the Sites tab, select the Site that contains the Project or Device you wish to edit. At the top, select either **Projects** or **Devices** accordingly. Search or scroll to find the desired item for editing and click the **Project or Device Details** button to start editing. Changes will save automatically as you make them.



Sitewide Jobs

Sitewide jobs allow you to set one Job to monitor changes, and backup all the devices in the site. To create a Sitewide job, select the **Settings** tab on the desired Site page. In the **File** section, scroll down until you find the **Sitewide Backup Schedule**. Fill out the form accordingly.

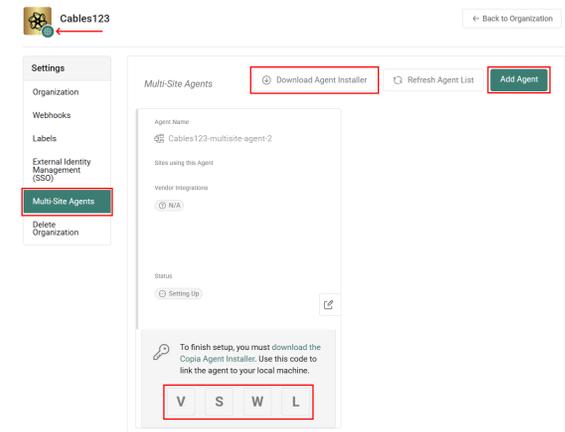
(NOTE: It is most common to auto-commit to the "Repositories Default Branch", but refer to the Copia documentation for more information)



Add a Copia Agent

When adding a Copia **Multi-Site** Agent, access your Organization setting via the **green cog** at the top left of the Home page. Choose the **Multi-Site Agents** section and press **Add Agent**. Fill in the form and press **Create Agent**. Make note of the **Code** provided. Now download the **Agent Installer**, install it on the target machine, log-in and enter the code when requested.

*(NOTE: To add a **Single Site** Agent, it is a similar process from the Agents tab of the Site page)*



Add/Trigger a single Job

A job for a **single** Project can be created during the Project creation process, or by using the Job Management page found via the Jobs tab at the top of the Site page.

There are multiple ways to trigger a single job for testing or backup listed below:

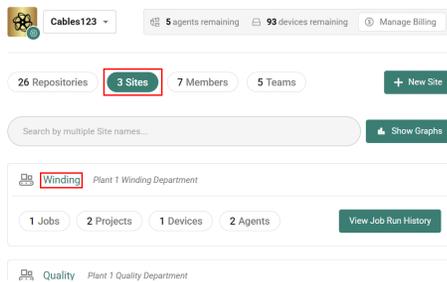
1. From the Job History page, click the down-arrow on the View Details button and "Repeat Job"
2. From the Project card, click the down-arrow on the Project Details button and "Backup Now"
3. From the Jobs -> Job Management page, click the "Backup Now" button.

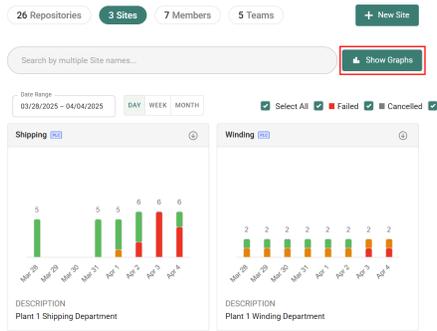
Accessing your Site

DeviceLink backups are available via the Sites page of the Copia Web App. Starting from the Home page, click the Sites tab to see a listing of Sites you have access to. Use the search or scroll to find your site and click it to go to your Site page.



Reviewing Summary Graphs

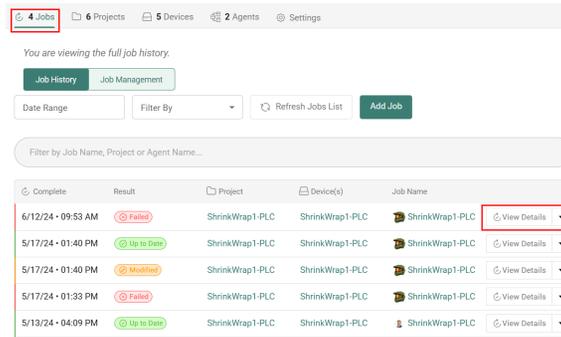
After accessing your site, click on the Show Graphs button on the right-side on the Search bar. Graphs for all Sites that have active jobs will be displayed. You can change the date/time range and filter your graphs. Graphs are also interactive, by clicking on the columns.



Reviewing Job Summary

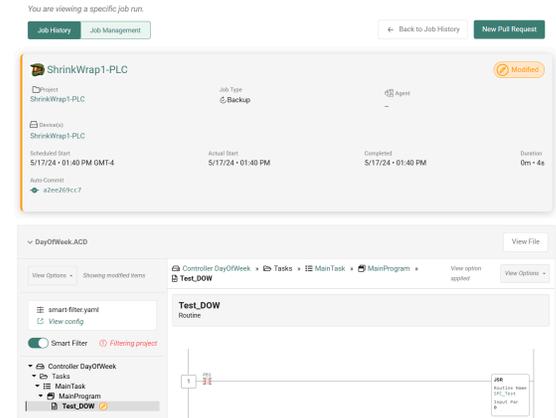
Once you access your site, you should be on the Job Summary page (accessible via the Jobs tab). Results of the latest jobs that you have permission to view are displayed.

Using the search bar, you can search and filter by Job, Project or Agent name. Options to View Details of a job are provided on the right, and using the arrow-menu, you have additional options.



Viewing Changes and Details

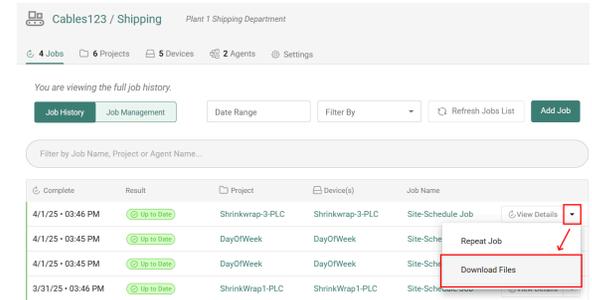
From the Job Summary page, the View Detail button will let you see the results of a Modified, Timed Out or Failed job. Click the button to see these details. If a job has Timed Out or Failed, then logs and troubleshooting data will be provided. If a Job is modified, a header providing the details of the Job (and optionally the auto-commit SHA) will be available. Additional details about the change can be found further down the page.



Retrieving a Backup (Job Summary)

DeviceLink backups can be retrieved directly from your Job Summary page. Up To Date and Modified Jobs provide a Download Files button accessible via the drop-down arrow next to the View Details button.

(NOTE: If Modified, it is recommended to press View Details to validate the backup is the correct project that you need)



Retrieving a Backup (Repository)

DeviceLink backups that have been auto-committed to the repository, can be retrieved directly from your repository Commit History. You can access these files either:

1. Via the View Details header, from the Job Summary page, as seen in the 1st image below
2. Via the Commits history page, accessible via your Source Control repository, as seen in the second image below
